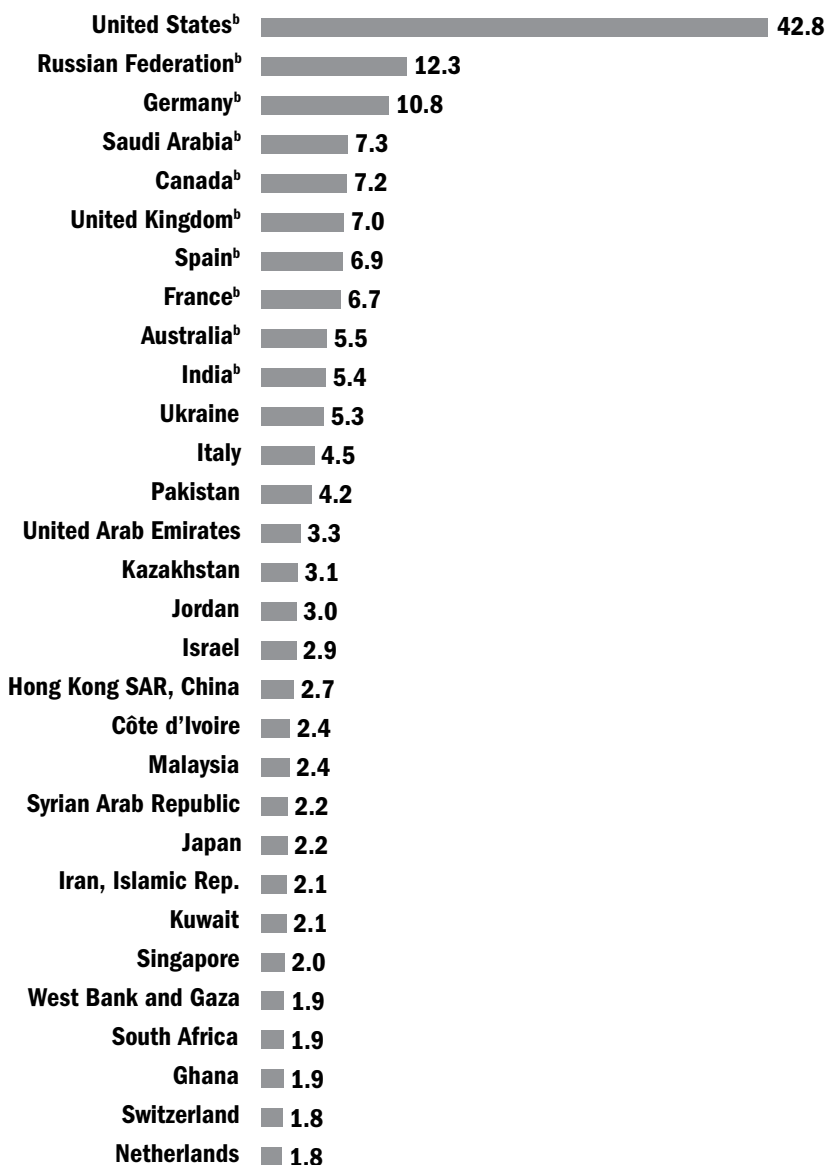

number of immigrants, millions



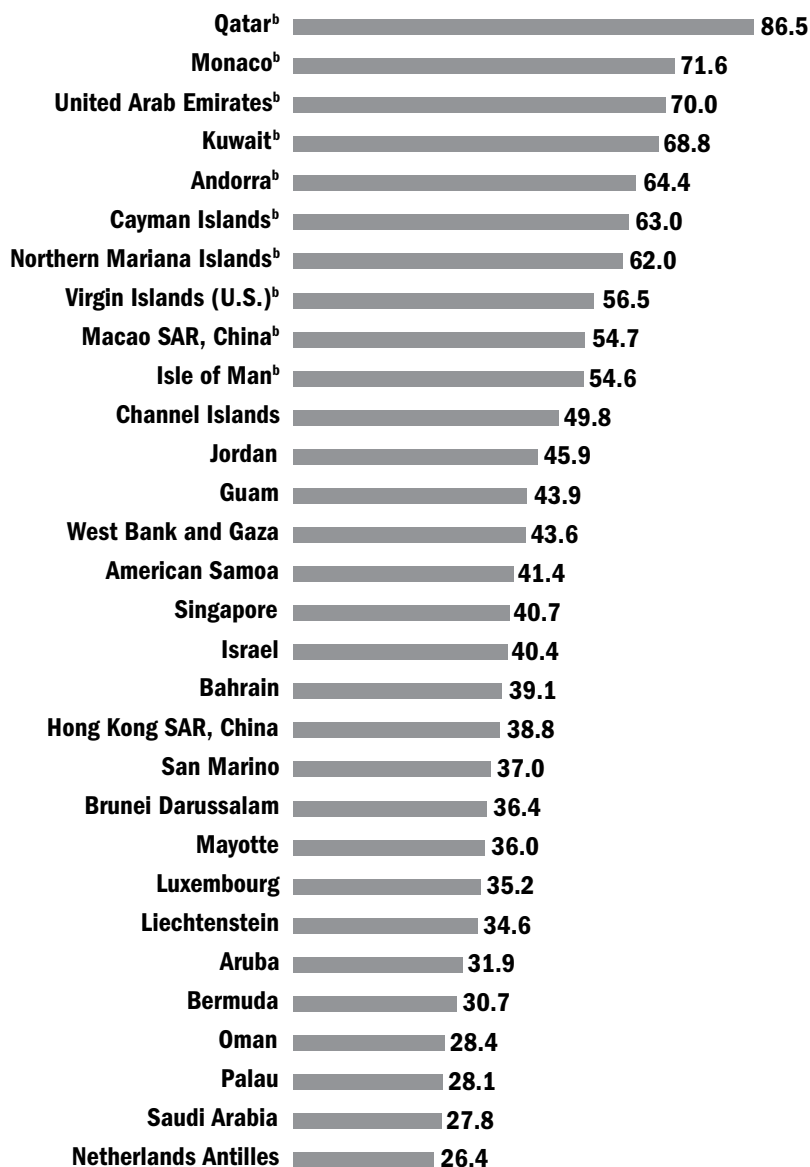

percentage of population



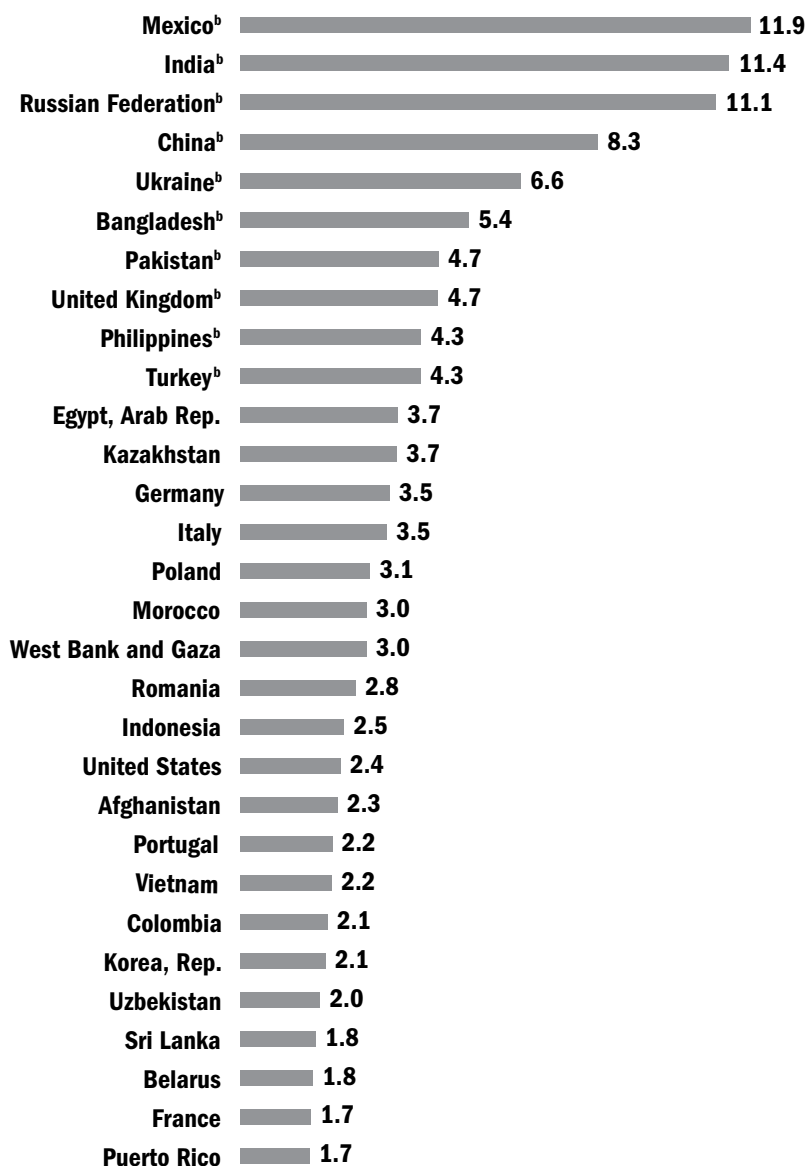

number of emigrants, millions



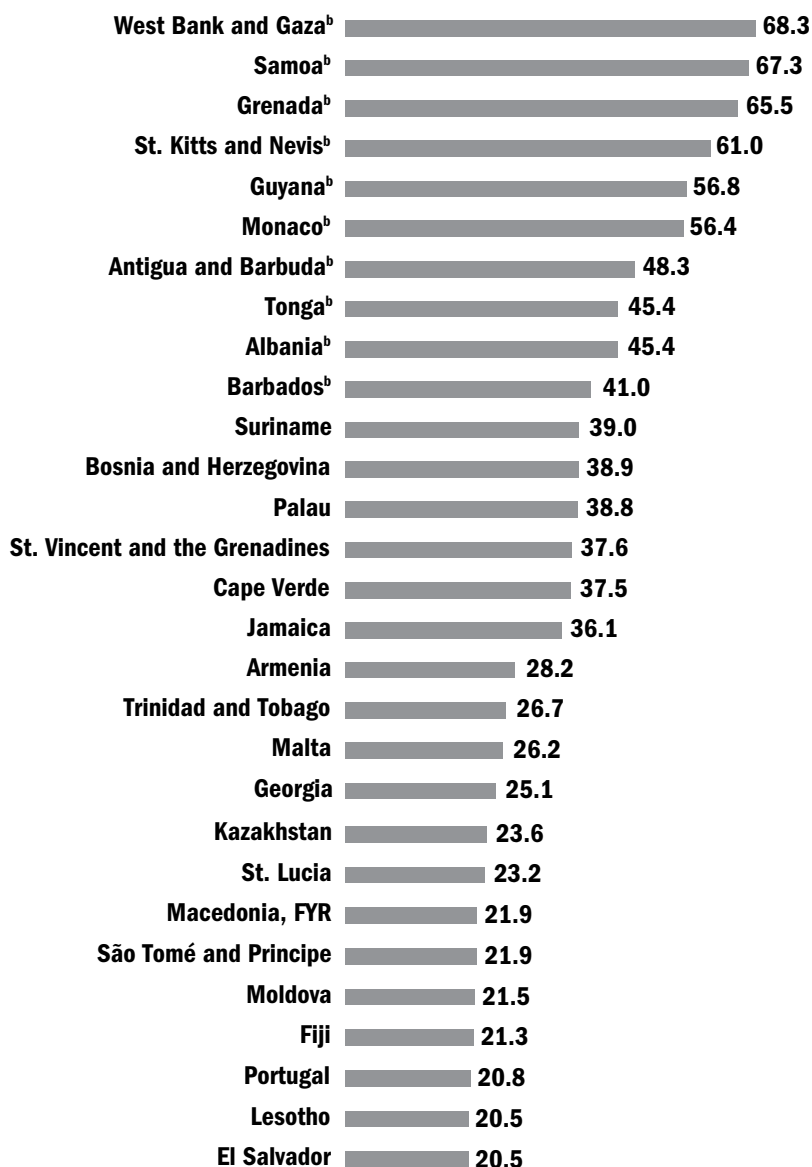

percentage of population



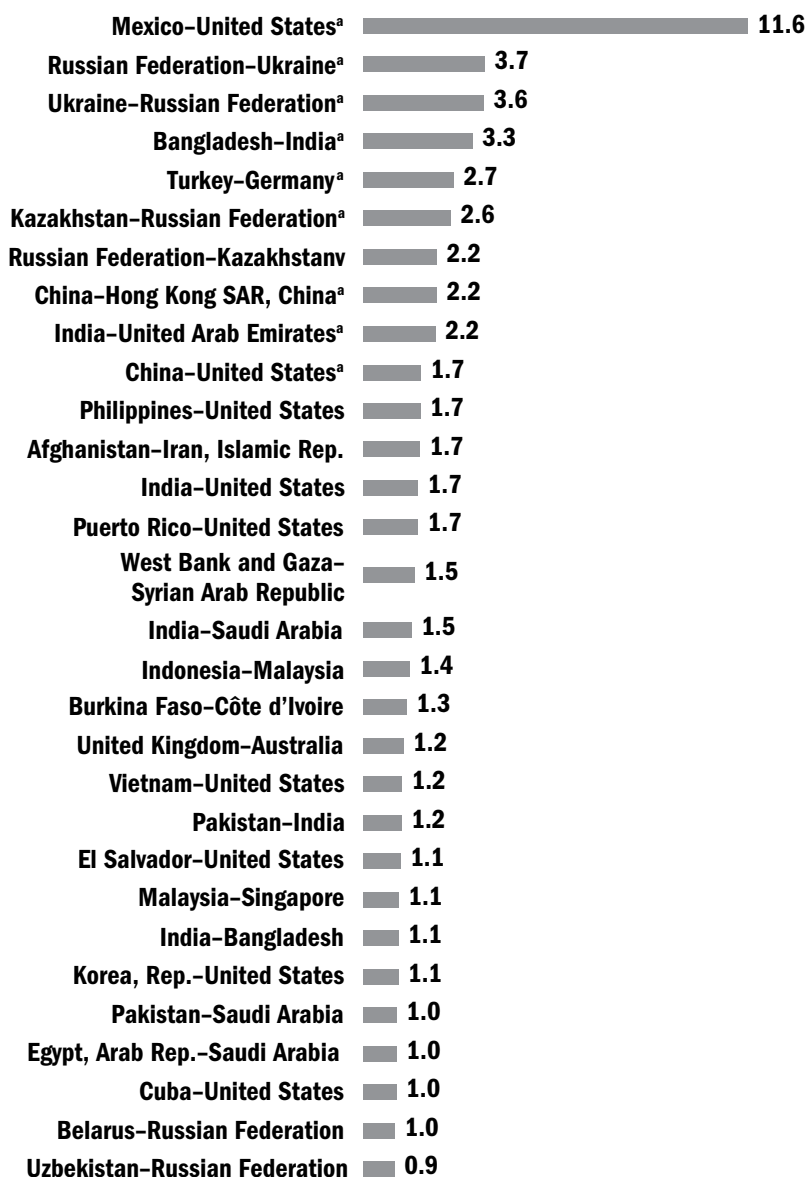

number of migrants, millions

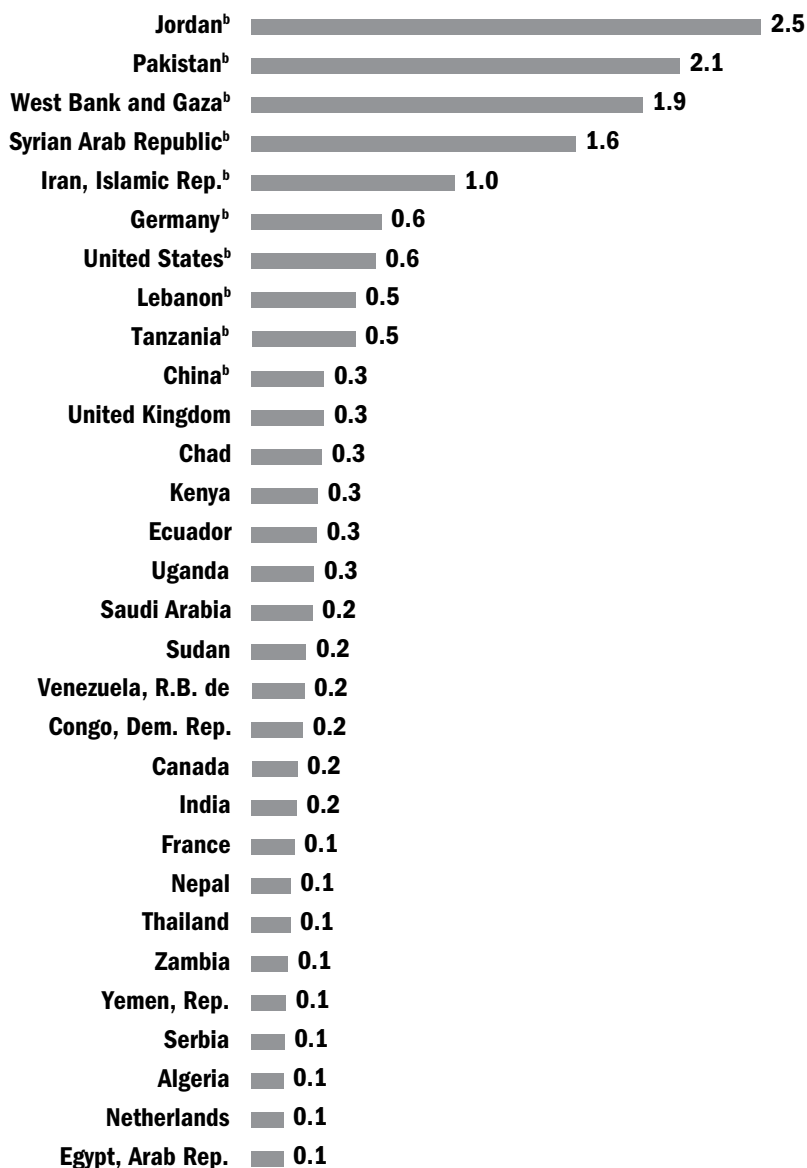

*number of migrants, millions*



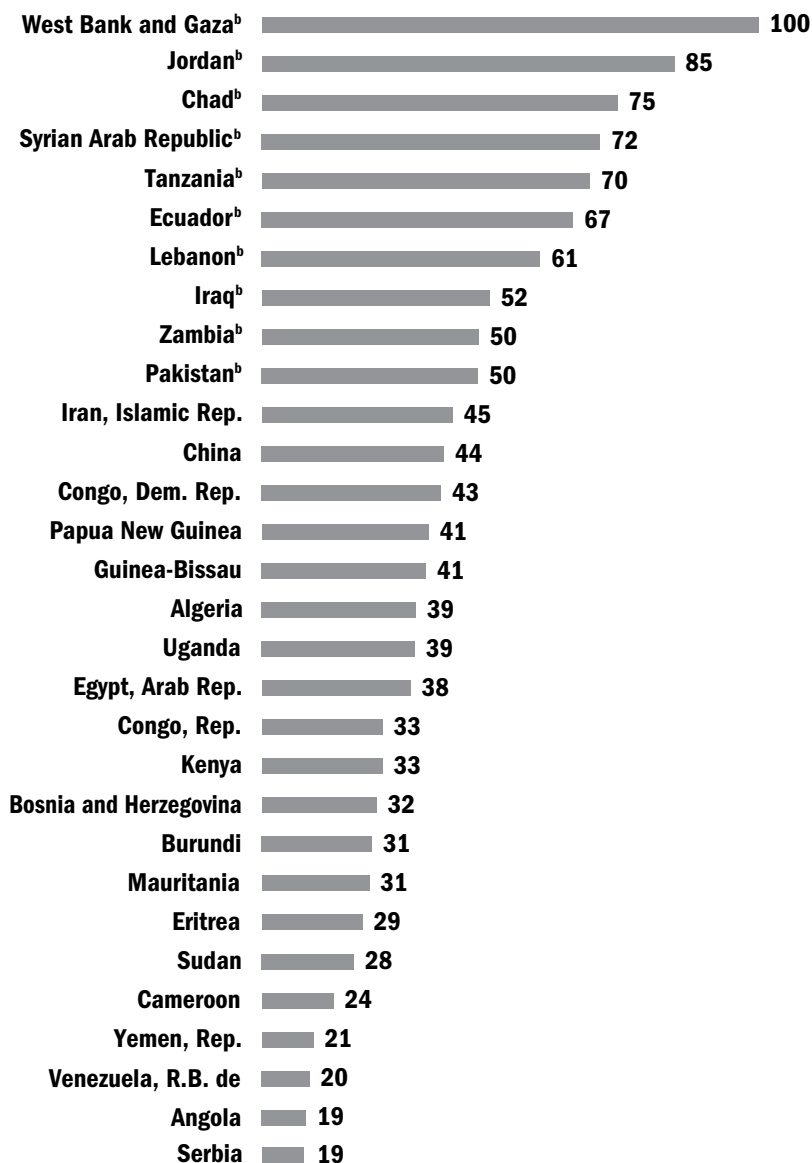

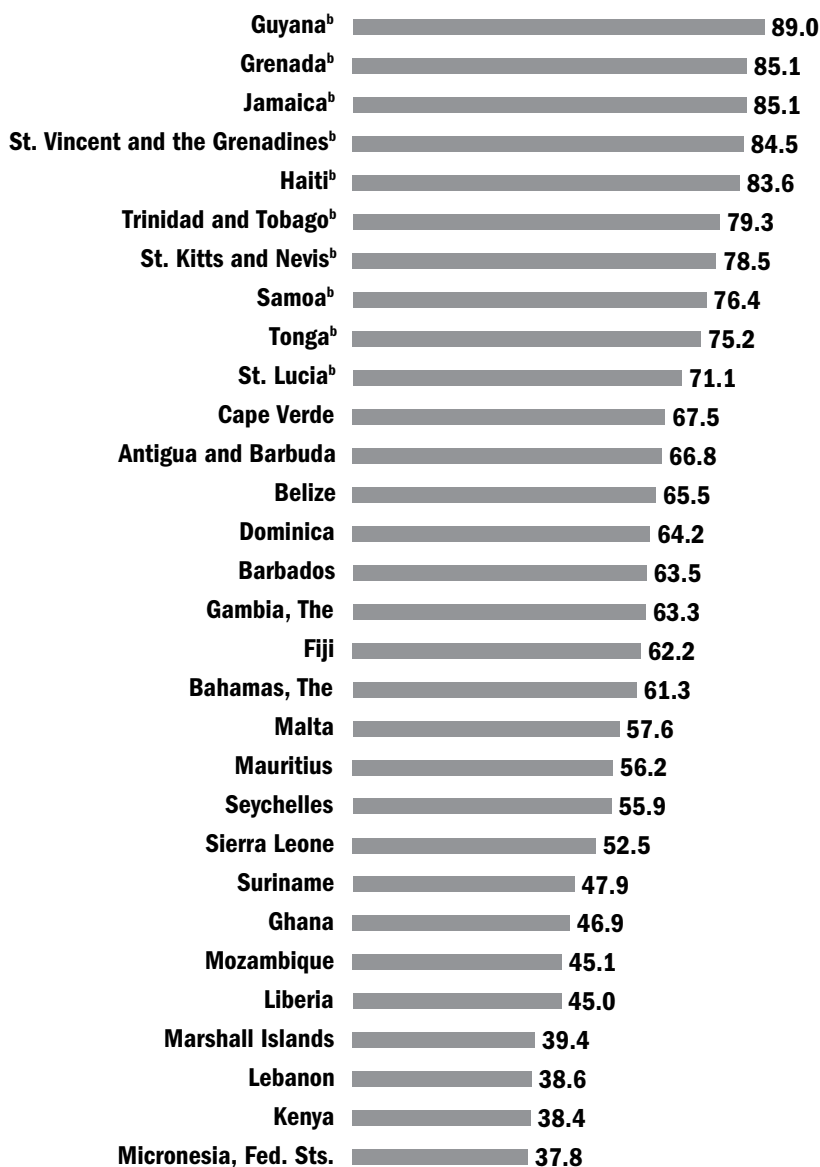

*number of migrants, thousands*



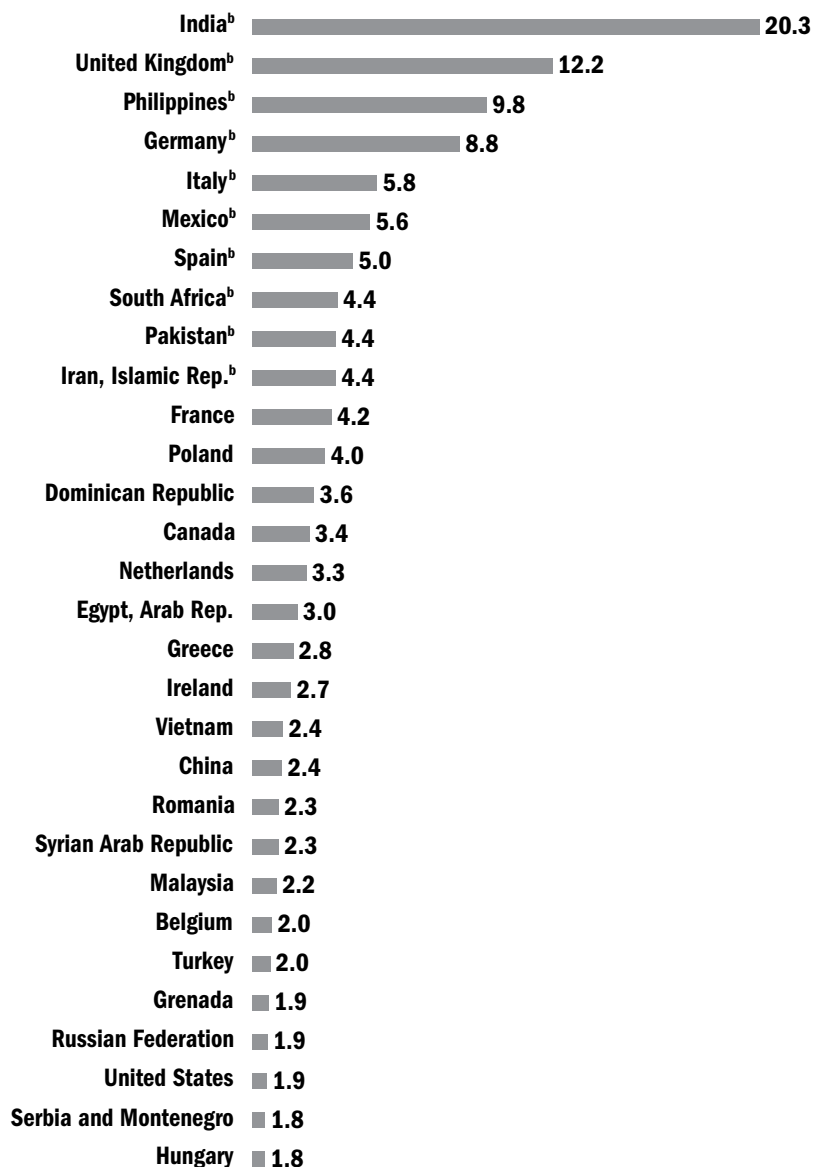

number of migrants, thousands



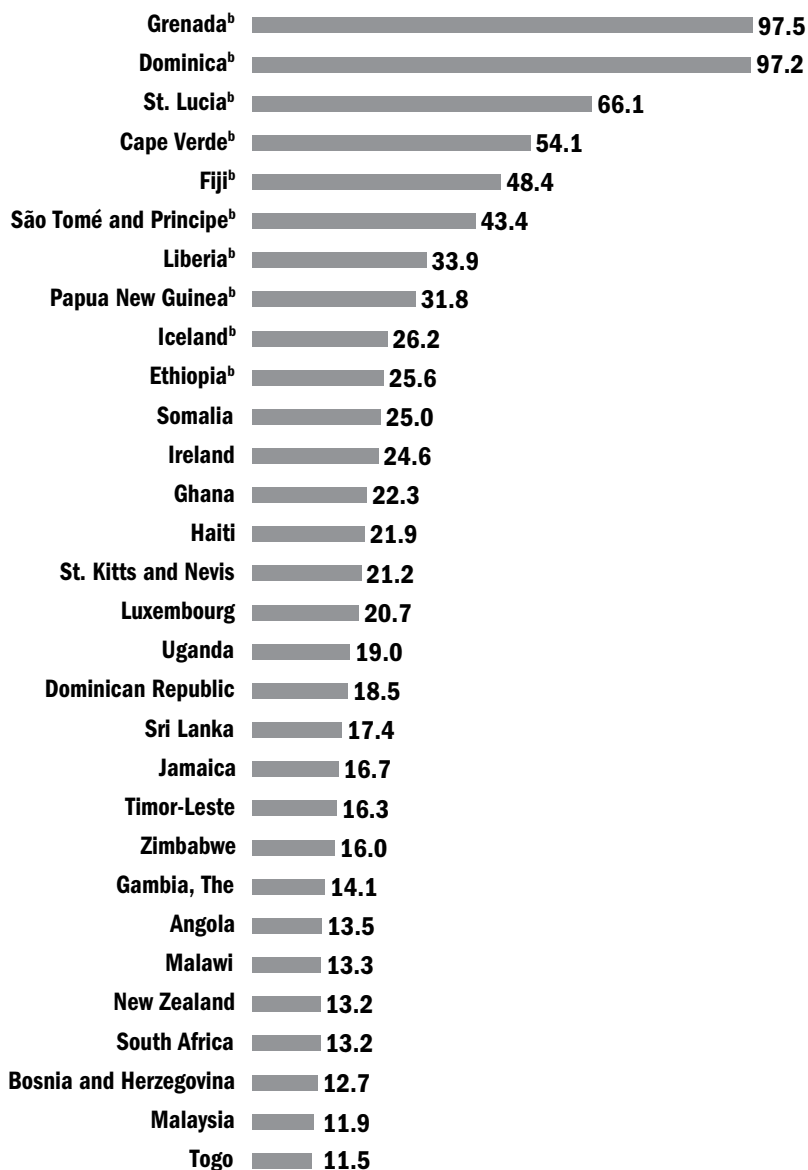

*percentage of total physicians trained in the country*



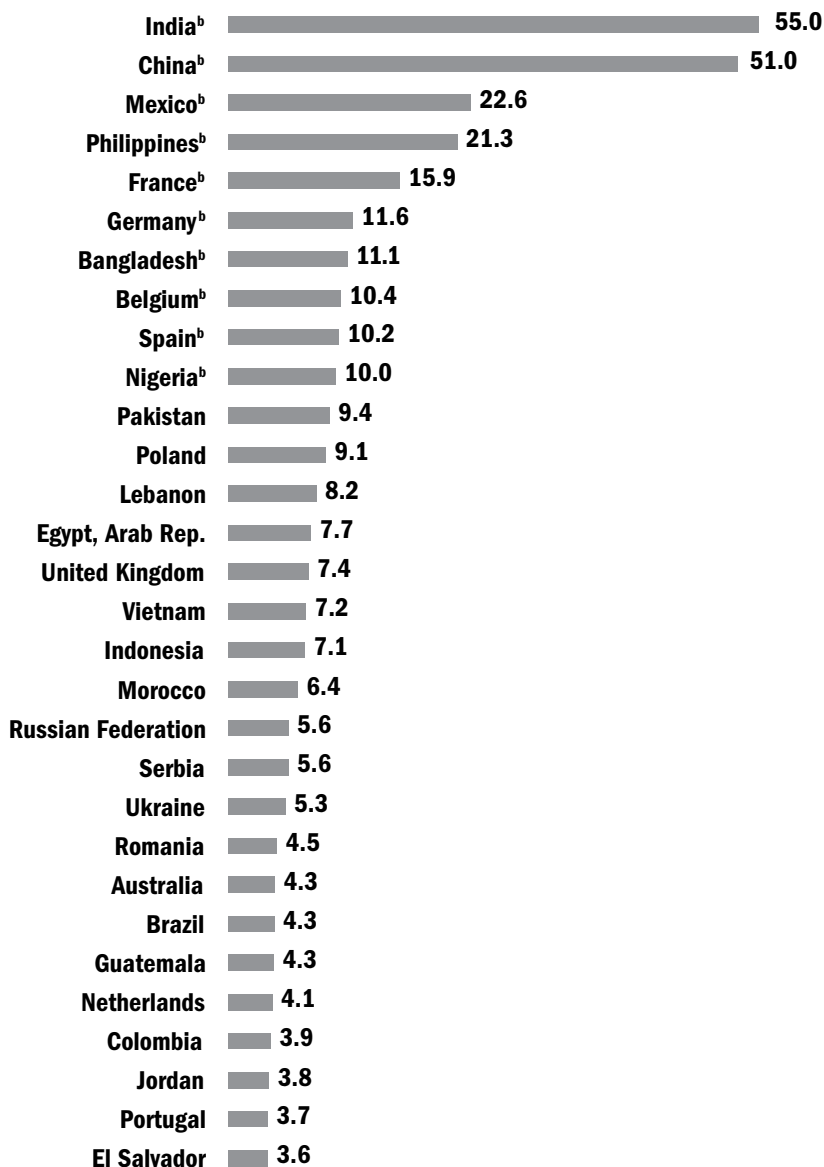

US\$ billions



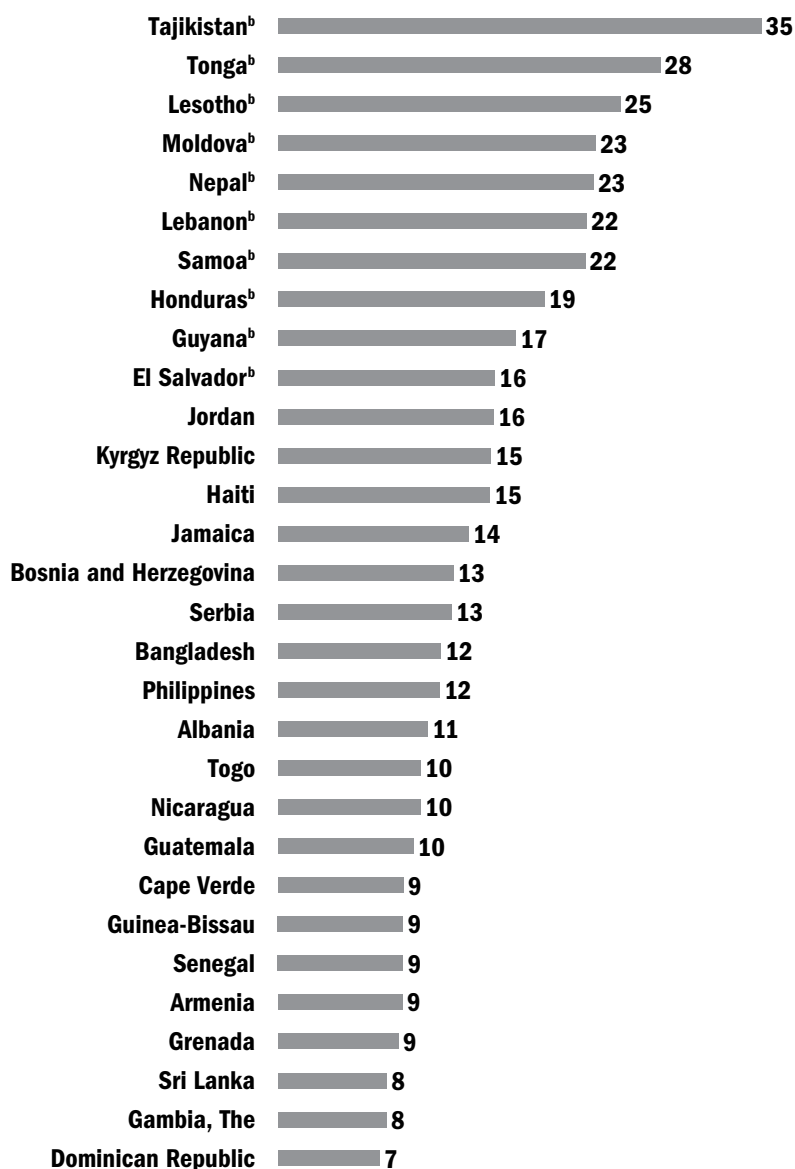

percentage of GDP



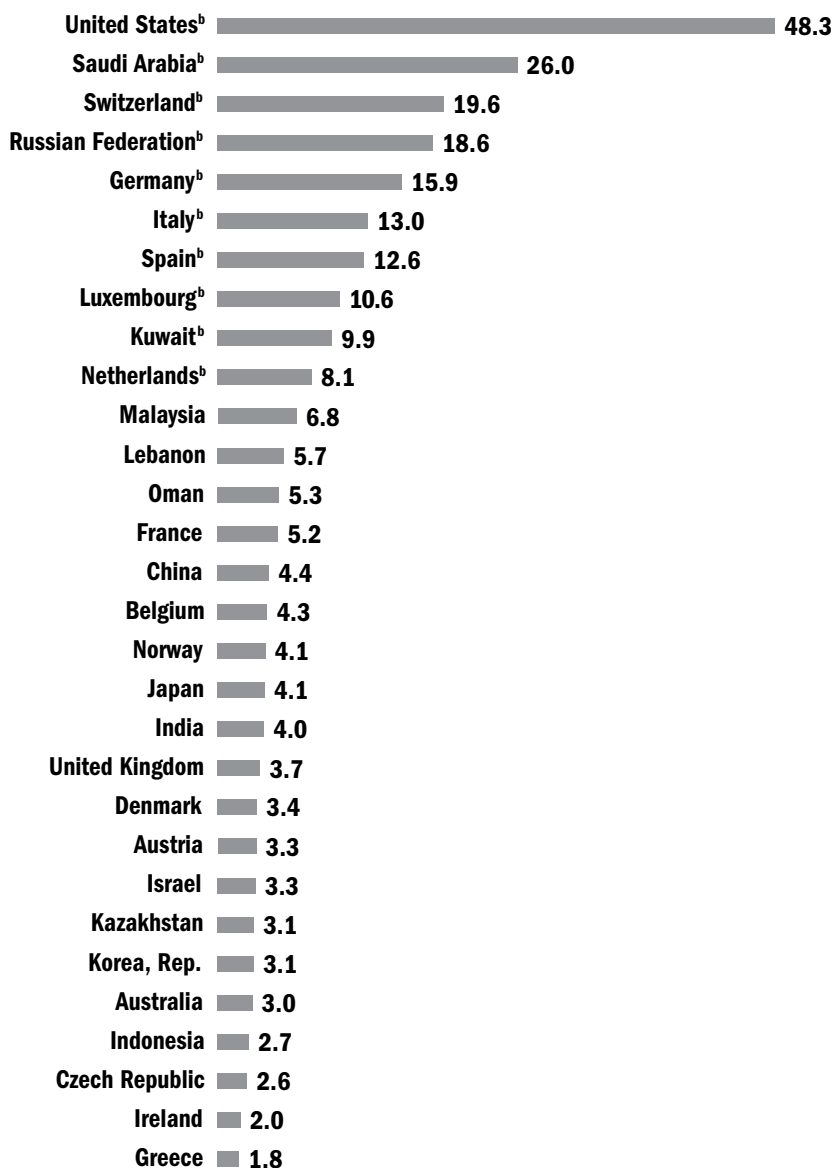

US\$ billions



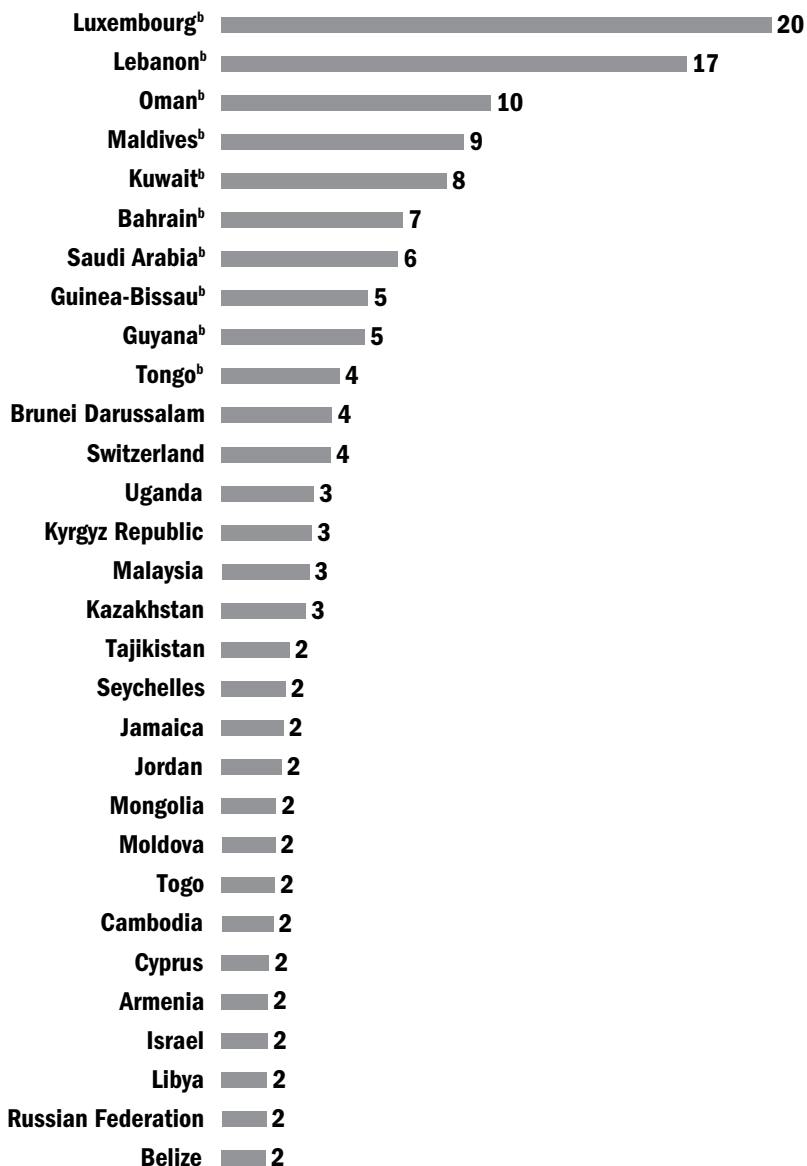
